**Columbus – January 7, 2008 – Steven D. Gladman**, President of The Affordable Housing Trust for Columbus and Franklin County has been appointed to serve on the Affordable Housing Advisory Council of the Federal Home Loan Bank of Cincinnati.

The Council is comprised of executives of state and local organizations who are actively providing for the housing and community development needs of low- and moderate-income persons and communities throughout the District.

**Mr. Gladman** has extensive management and community development experience. In his previous position as the Executive Director for the Columbus Apartment Association, was significantly involved in community development issues at the local and state level. He has served on the Governor's Affordable Housing Task Force and was Executive Director for Ohio Energy Action Corporation. **Mr. Gladman** is a graduate of The Ohio State University, with an MA in Adult Education, BA Political Science and is certified by the Non-Profit Management-Institute for Organization Management. He is a member of numerous professional and community organizations.

Founded in 2001 by Columbus and Franklin County, The Housing Trust fosters the development of affordable homes and apartments through a revolving loan fund to for-profit and not-for-profit developers. The Trust carried net assets of more than \$12 million. The Housing Trust will lend more than \$8 million in 2007.
